



GUS KENWORTHY - FREE SKIING

Columbia

Gus Kenworthy made history as one of the first two openly gay men to compete for the U.S. at the 2018 Winter Olympics. He qualified for PyeongChang - his second Olympic team - when he finished second at the Toyota U.S. Grand Prix at Mammoth Mountain in California.

NATHAN CHEN - FIGURE SKATING

Nathan Chen became the first man to complete six quads in a free skate. He went into the U.S. Nationals with tons of momentum, and cemented his place on the 2018 Olympic team with his second national title. He is the reigning U.S Champion and Four Continents Champion.

MIRAI NAGASU - FIGURE SKATING

Mirai Nagasu started skating when she was 5 years old in Pasadena, California. She said, "My goal is to accept any challenge that life throws me and to become a better person from each experience. I'm going to make mistakes and have success; I hope that under all circumstances, I can come away from everything as a role model and an inspiration."

SHAUN WHITE - SNOWBOARDING

4-time Olympian Shaun White has notched up a few gold medals. He holds the record for the most X-Games gold medals and he has won 10 ESPY Awards.

LINDSEY VONN - ALPINE SKIING

Lindsey Vonn has compiled more World Cup wins—78—than any female ski racer in history. Although plagued by injuries that ended her 2013, 2014 and 2016 seasons prematurely, Vonn appeared

Tesla Currency

A legacy of genius and power

By Larry Crane



t the beginning of the automotive century American gas-car makers were vigorously promoting their product against the limitations of the electrics and the steamers. All suffered from complex — primitive science and a population of horsemen.

Concurrently, Nikola Tesla was busy creating new sciences so profound they were unlikely to be even understood

until the following century.

Futurist entrepreneur Colonel Alfred Pope made fine bicycles toward the same goal. He refitted his long narrow Columbia bicycle frame-tube plant in Hartford, Connecticut, as the Motor Carriage Department and within four years was delivering seven different types of electricpowered vehicles. Venture capitalist, William C. Whitney, offered \$3,000,000 for a piece of the Columbia and Electric Vehicle Company. As the new century arrived, J. Pierpont Morgan had a similar inspiration to support the fantastic scientific advances being accomplished by Nikola Tesla. Wardenclyff, his new laboratory for the study of electrical power transmission, was constructed in Shoreham, Long Island, including a 187-foot tower (and another 120 feet below ground) with its great copper dome from which Tesla planned to transmit enormous electrical current around the globe — for both power and

signals. Tesla wrote that his 1901 tower's ability to transmit information would someday allow the creation of "an inexpensive instrument, not bigger than a watch, [which] will enable its bearer to hear anywhere, on sea or land, music or song however distant." (As the concept developed in his head, it became weaponized as a "Death Ray," the idea of massive electrical power being focused across oceans to destroy military targets made Tesla even a bit more frightening — and reclusive.) Morgan finally asked, "If anyone can draw on the power,

where do we put the meter?" Morgan's support suddenly ended.

Electricity and steam were in competition to be the answer to personal transport for the new century. In fact, in 1899, the first self-propelled vehicle to exceed a-mile-per-minute was Camille Jenatzy's double-ended bullet propelled by two 25kw motors fed by 200 volts and 124 amps, for a combined 68 horsepower. That established the world's speed record. It was six years before the American Stanley brothers covered two miles in a minute in their steam-powered streamliner.

These two systems were in a "heated" battle with the noisy, smelly, explosive "infernal" combustion engine for the hearts, minds and

bank drafts of the growing cadre of motorists considering their options. Then, of course, an exploratory oil well erupted conveniently on "Spindletop" hill in southeast Texas on January 10, 1901 and flowed 17,500,00 barrels in 1902, promising combustible energy forever. The following year Dr. H. Nelson Jackson and Sewall Crocker drove a gaspowered Winton from San Francisco to New York and introduced the automobile as the tool of independent travel, quite free of railroad routes — and schedules. They unwittingly set in motion the death of the electric coach as anything but an urban shopping car. Colonel Pope hedged Whitney's capital by including one vehicle with a com-



bustion engine in his product lineup. But Whitney soon bought him out and moved the business to New York City. The rebranded Electric Automobile Company's most successful horseless product was the ubiquitous electric Hansom Cab.

Bring in Carl Fisher, a development partner in the Prest-O-Lite compressed acetylene auto headlight (the replacement for the carriage-light candle in a crystal vase), it quickly became a universal component. In 1909 Fisher sold his one-third partnership to Union Carbide for \$5.6-million and launched his plan for a cross-country motor road he called the Lincoln Highway, connecting Times Square in New York City with San Francisco's Lincoln Park. The Official Road Guide of the Lincoln Highway gave detailed instructions for navigating a continent where useful roads were either unfinished, or even unplanned, but it brought an independent population west.

Within half a century garages were included in every home plan and often had to accommodate two gas-powered cars. For the remainder of the century the automobile lexicon included something about translucent urban atmosphere rapidly becoming opaque. That and a 1973 oil embargo conspired to give us a more modest view of our energy requirements — and a more ardent look for alternatives for both stability and mobility.

We lost Nikola Tesla and his fervent cerebral processor early in 1943. He had been granted 112 patents, along with a great number of honors, for his scientific achievements, many of which were beyond the practical capabilities of his contemporaries. But his inspiration continued to drive young minds toward the future.

In 1961 Robert Noyce discovered he could construct a miniature

electronic system with particle pattern applied to a tiny silicon chip. In Japan, Akira Yoshino developed a lithium-ion rechargeable battery in 1986. Together they changed the dimensions of energy development and processing for the NEXT century.

Martin Eberhard and Marc Tarpenning met in 1990 and cofounded NuvoMedia in 1997 after several years of practical experience in the art and science of their computer engineering degrees. The NuvoMedia "exit plan" resulted in a \$187 million cushion while they developed a plan. They discovered AC Propulsion Incorporated and its "tzero" ("t0" a mathematical symbol to denote the beginning of time within a system) sports car that delivered 100% torque at start. Tesla Motors was incorporated in 2003. The Executive Summary for investors included: 0-60 in less than 3.9 seconds; World-class handling; 100 mpg equivalent; Zero tailpipe emissions; 300 mile range; Zero maintenance for 100,000 miles; and a selling price of less than half of the cheapest competitive sports car.

The first 30-minute presentation to Elon Musk (already deep into SpaceX) lasted two hours. He shared their vision and added: "Make a vastly superior car, not just a car that sucks less." Musk led the \$7.5 million investment round and became chairman of the board. A Lotus-built working mule was on the track in November of 2004 and JB Straubel the new chief technical officer (and brilliant achiever in his own right) was its driver. A quarter scale clay body-design model was seen in 2005 and the Tesla Roadster launch party at the Santa Monica Airport was a resounding success in July of 2006. There were more than 120 \$100,000 full price buyers and the personality challenges began in earnest. In August of 2007 Eberhard resigned and Elon Musk,

already in for \$55 million, became CEO in October of 2008 while the "Whitestar" project was already underway. It was introduced as the Tesla Model S, a four-door sedan capable of 0-60 in 3.2 seconds, in April of 2009. Multiple versions followed with varying battery range and with or without four-wheel drive. We know it's a success because we see them everywhere in our neighborhood.

Not unexpected was the delayed launch of Tesla's brilliant Model X SUV. The reason is no less unexpected: more unique features, fully developed and logically functional. The introduction was delayed more than three years — to get everything right. During its September 2015 launch party in Fremont, Musk explained: "In retrospect, we would not have done so much in the way of features and functionality for the X. People are going to get an incredible car that does so many things no other car does, but it didn't have to do quite as many things.

"Now that it's done, I think anyone who buys it is going to love it. So too, the new Model 3. It was predicted to be in full production (20,000/month) last December. Only 260 were delivered. Our Canoga Park dealer (Westfield Topanga) has yet to have a Model 3 in their inventory. At the price of a 3 Series BMW it will be the star

Be In Tune With The Moon *...for your garden's success!*

ou might think I am a little looney when I tell you gardening by lunar cycles could benefit your garden. I have been growing vegetables for a decade and never thought stages of the moon could boost my plants' health and guarantee a bumper harvest. The Farmer's Almanac is a believer and many of our ancestors have had successes, so I might as well give it a try this season!

Don't worry, being in tune with the moon doesn't mean you need to start gardening at dusk, even though some diehard gardeners actually do! Where the moon is in relationship to the sun notifies the gardener what to plant and when. Following the moon phases will bring you closer to nature's patterns and success in your garden.

Unfortunately, most gardeners have lost sight of this age-old tradition. The truth be told, lunar planting has been practiced by farmers dating back thousands of years. Civilizations from the Nile and Euphrates River valleys have gardened by the moon. Some scientists might balk at this theory but the proof is in the harvest; ask any lunar gardener!

HOW IT WORKS THE MOON'S PHASES

The Moon revolves around the Earth every 28 days reflecting differing amounts of sun depending on its angle toward the light of the sun. Lunar phases pivot from the New Moon through to the Full Moon and back again. Each time this occurs there are four phases or quarters, each lasting 7 days. The first two quarters is considered the "waxing stage" when the moon is dark and the light becomes increasingly visible until the moon is full. The last 2 quarters are considered the "waning stage", when the full moon's light starts to decrease until there isn't any light on the moon; this is called the New Moon. Then the cycle starts all over again.

LET THERE BE LIGHT!

The theory is that the moon's gravitational influence effects rise and fall of the tides as well as the soil moisture, plant sap and water table. When the moon is full, lunar gravity pulls the tides up and draws the moisture of the earth

up towards the surface. The extra moisture in the soil encourages the seed to swell, burst and sprout. Timing has a major effect on the seeds' success of germination.

The light from the moon also influences the growth of your plants. The first 2 quarters, the moon is in its waxing stage. The increasing light stimulates the plant's growth and its leaves. This is the best time to plant annuals that bear their fruit above ground.

During the 3rd and 4th quarters, when the full moon's light begins to decrease or wane, energy goes to the plant's roots and the gravitational pull draws the moisture and the plant's roots down. The growth of the leaves slow down, making it the optimum time to plant your root crops and bulbs.

There are times when you shouldn't plant at all. Never plant during the full moon and new moon; they are considered "barren" signs. Avoiding planting on the first and last quarter days is also a lunar gardening practice.

So, remember:

- Waxing moon plant leafy greens or plants that grow above ground.
- Waning moon plant root or bulb plants.

WAXING MOON

Pick fruits and vegetables that you intend to eat right away. Because the water content of the ingredients is higher, salads are crunchier during the waxing moon.

• During the first quarter, from the new moon to the half- full moon, plant above ground annuals, particularly leafy plants which produce their seed outside the fruit. Examples: asparagus, cabbage, celery, endive, and spinach.



New Potatoes

• **During the second quarter**, from the halffull moon to the full moon, plant annuals that grow above ground; vine and produce seed inside the fruit. Examples: beans, peas, peppers, squash, eggplant, tomatoes, and cucumbers.

You can plant garlic, melons, hay, and grains and cereals, in either the first or second quarter.

TIP: During periods of drought, sow seeds when the moon is waxing, as close to the full moon as possible.

WANING MOON


During the entire waning phase, sow root vegetables. Examples: beets, radishes, carrots, parsnips, potatoes, onions and turnips.

• During the third quarter, from the full moon to half-full moon, plant bulb and root crops; any crops which are planted in one season to winter produce yields the following year. Examples: onions, potatoes, rhubarb, grapes and berries.

TIP: During the dark of the moon, plants should rest. This is a good time to kill weeds because they won't grow back.

After navigating the silver-blue bullet around a few pesky road bumps, the Italian-American Stallion unfurled himself from the hug-the-road height of his pristine car - and the charm offensive began. He previously developed and launched his "Healthy Planet Nutrition" line of whey protein nutritional supplements that instantly became a best seller at Whole Foods Markets, Sprouts and other major retailers across the country. His series of online and TV spots for Old Spice in 2011, as part of the "New Old Spice Guy Fabio" campaign resulted in over 190 million views on the Internet & 68,000 new friends on Facebook and was the Number 1 Viral Video Campaign of the Year. His Super Bowl XL commercial for Nationwide Insurance was the most viewed commercial of the game. He helped Gillette launch its Oral-B Sensitive Advantage Toothbrush campaign. In 2003, Fabio started his own signature line of women's apparel at the Sam's Club division of Wal-Mart with stores reporting increased sales by as much as 2,000%. Previously, he authored numerous romance novels, a fitness book, created a work-out video and served as a spokesperson for the American Cancer Society. Fabio lost his sister to ovarian cancer at a young age.

An avid car and motorcyclist enthusiast, as well as a technology buff, Fabio's passions were strongly evident in the weeks we worked with him. Dynamic and super-charged with goal-directed energy, this Human Stallion charmed the large group who encircled him. Friends arrived at his cover shoot to show their support - and the ensuing conversations were elevated with wit, quick repartee and a healthy dose of laughter. This is a man who has dived into life with the velocity of a titan.

Q: You were born and raised in Italy. Your childhood friend, Allesandra Gerini, with whom you went to school, describes you as a fiercely loyal and protective friend who stood up to schoolyard bullies and people whose actions were hypocritical. He says you were never afraid to confront people or situations where you felt a strong sense of injustice. Explain that. **FABIO:** From a very young age I was always bothered by the concept of bullies. The idea that someone would enjoy picking on others, or that their life would improve by picking on others, seemed strange. The fact that bullies would always torment the smaller or weaker kids just seemed unfair. I was always bigger than other kids my age so I had no problem standing up to bullies and saying, "Okay, if you want to fight with someone, fight with me". I got into a lot of fights. It was only later that I realized that the bullies were acting out because of their own insecurities. In fact, when I was living in NY, I ran into one of the bullies I beat up as a kid, and he apologized to me saying that he was only doing that because he was getting beaten up at home and didn't know how to deal with it.

Q: You have a rich history. You were raised by solidly-—devoted parents. What are your best memories of that childhood?

I am very blessed to have 2 amazing parents who gave us plenty of love and attention. More than anything else, they gave us their time. They were there for us and created a sense of protection so that we felt safe and free to grow and explore with a sense of confidence. **FABIO:** I am very blessed to have 2 amazing parents who gave us plenty of love and attention. Don't get me wrong - there was also plenty of screaming, lectures and the occasional smack to the head - we are Italian after all.

Q: At age 13 you visited the United States with your dad. It made an indelible and immediate impression on you – so much so that you said to your dad, "I'm moving here when I'm 18". What was it about this country that made such an impact on you?

FABIO: I was very fortunate as a child in that growing up in Italy, we always traveled every summer and I got the chance to see different cultures and different ways of thinking. I first came to America when I was 13 years old. I loved it! I felt right at home and comfortable because it's such a melting pot with so many different influences and ideas.

Q: After working with a top photographer from Italy, you moved to New York at age 19. Your success was immediate. Ford Models signed you up and literally the next day, you jetted off to Hawaii for an 18-day shoothaving closed one of the biggest modeling campaigns in the USA. Describe that initiation and how you felt.

FABIO: It all happened so fast... Originally, I had moved to Seattle to attend University and model on the side. A friend passed my card to an agent at Ford Modeling Agency in New York who called me. Seeing as I was way more interested in partying than studying, a trip to New York sounded like fun. The agent at Ford signed me on the spot. They told me that they were sending me out that day for a casting even though the campaign had already been booked. I met a fashion photographer named Barry McKinley. He immediately called the client and insisted that they had to replace the 2 male models they had hired for the job, and use me as the only male model instead. The next day my agent called me to say I had gotten the job. The client was a new company called

The Gap and the job was for a 20-day shoot in Hawaii with Kathy Ireland and Andie MacDowell. If there's an exception for every rule, then I'm the exception for "Stay in School".

Q: You and a core group of other models – took modeling to another level in the USA. You strongly believe that success is dependent on a strong philosophical approach to life. Describe what you believe lights the fire that creates success?

FABIO: Success comes in many forms but it comes down to not just what you believe, but how you believe. By that I mean that some people believe 50%, some 75%. I believe in the infinite. It's a different mindset and a different way of seeing things. It helps you overcome obstacles and challenges. God is the foundation for everything and as they say it's easier to swim with the tide than against it. Miracles happen but if you don't believe that they can, then don't be disappointed when they don't. One way or another your expectation will come true.

Q: You became just about every woman's fantasy of a man. Every time the publishers of romance novels placed you on the book's front cover – sales soared. What do you believe are the key elements of successful romantic relationships?

FABIO: For me it's all about balance. We are comprised of 3 elements: Body, Mind and Spirit. You need to have internal balance to then find someone who shares those same traits. Most importantly: 1) Don't Settle. Have the patience to wait for the right one; but 2) Make sure to have fun along the way!

So the Color of Our Backbone Is Black

know I owe you a detailed report on the **Spring-Summer 2018 fashion trends**, since in the previous article I talked mainly about **transparency**, the most relevant look of the season. But meanwhile, the year has started off with a remarkable fashion experience that broadcasted what was happening socially, where waves of courage, energy and solidarity pressed forward to a much-needed change in the gender equality paradigm. So you see why I can't go straight to chatting about **fringes and feathers**, **pastels**, **plastics** and **polka-dots**, without saying first a few things about the style choice that represented, at the beginning of this year,

a landmark in fashion history and in its social significance. By the time you read my lines, the entire Awards Season will already be concluded – done, gone, talked about, dissected, probed, envied, frowned upon, or gloated over. People will go about their lives, pursuing projects and relationships that give their lives meaning, in both a private and a social sense. However, I think that the Golden Globes 2018's all black dress code will go down in history as a testimony of fashion's often scorned ability to make powerful social statements and to elicit cultural change.

In Europe at the time, I sat in front of the TV in the wee hours of the morning, waiting for the Golden Globes red carpet to unfold, unnerved with mixed feelings. I knew about Time's Up calling for the attendees to show support for the movement by wearing black to the ceremony, and

really appreciated the initiative as a cathartic way of speaking up about a toxic state of affairs that went unchecked since the beginning of time, but I wasn't sure at all of how this black dress protest movement would work or how effective it would be. There was a certain risk of drowning a strong social statement in a sea of boring little black dresses and standard black tuxedoes, as it was of indulging a fashion style-code for aesthetic and egotistic sake, while forgetting entirely the revolutionary motive behind it. Providentially, it didn't happen like that. I watched with pleasure and increasing pride every arrival of the night, as they were photographed, cheered from the sides, interviewed about their movement, and justly honored.

For a cut-throat world as divisive, narcissistic, conceited and competitive as Hollywood proved to be time and again, to be able to rise to the occasion in unison, so selflessly, so kind to each other, and in such good humor, it demonstrated not only a firm and resolute collective character, but also the maturity of a social group that has finally grown a backbone. It was a great moment, with substantial social consequence, as well as a great fashion moment, a protest symbol as part of a larger, deliberate statement.

The sea of black showed women standing together united, asking for a complete change of the rules that have debased their lives and experiences for far too long. What added to it was also the designers' extraordinary creativity in managing to set apart each one of the hundreds of attendees – no two black dresses looked alike, no two tuxedos were identical. Each participant, emerging young hopeful or fully-fledged celebrity, got his moment in the spotlight, her message

listened to, and enjoyed their individuality in solidarity. Like every time when people do something significant that is in line with what they believe, the experience felt transformative and exhilarating.

I crossed my fingers for the feeling to last and the potentially-iconic movement to evolve with wisdom, that is to avoid falling out of one extreme into another and the too tempting dérapage in between. Born and raised in Europe, with a decades-long life experience on two continents, where I got to work with several different cultures, I'm comfortable with men's gallantry, friendly banter, witty innuendos and clever flirting, as I've come to know how to receive a compliment gracefully and diffuse with humor awkward attempts or ambiguous situations. But things are never quite so simple, nor are they only black and white. As women, we walk an extremely fine line to navigate through a world where a patriarchal, obsolete mindset is the norm, and the simple notion of being valued as equals at all times remains a daily uphill battle; yet we crave men's respect and support in our lives as much as we crave their attention, affection and love. Nevertheless, what we wear and how we wear it should always be perceived as the creative expression of



ourselves, and never as an invitation or excuse for any kind of aggression.

The 21st century woman doesn't put up with a culture of gender-based victimhood anymore, as she's too busy creating an environment of normality, regard, savoirfaire and joie de vivre. Speaking of which, respecting women's passion for fashion and for the infinite possibilities it generates to celebrate our individuality, should be a mark of any civilized society. For dignity, like beauty, is in the eyes of the beholder as well.

The fashion styles introduced by this Spring-Summer season are a welcome visual and attitudinal antidote to any sense of hopelessness, helplessness or disdain still felt by women worldwide.

green and glossy copper.

Denim is another staple of the season, present in a deep, double-dark indigo shade with much less embellishments and ripped-effects, giving a polished, more sophisticated look. Head-totoe denim is seen proper even as evening attire for a formal event, when bejeweled and paired with exclusive accessories.

looks from worldwide runways beg to differ.



How to Prevent Divorce from Ruining Your Financial Life

here are many aspects to a divorce. There's the legal aspect – and it is huge. The divorce laws in California are voluminous, complex, and often murky. There's the financial aspect – and that is overwhelming as well. Many of us who've gone through divorce are all too familiar with the uncertainty of what our finances will look like post-divorce. And, of course, there's the emotional aspect – which permeates every other part of the process.

A good family law attorney will be able to guide you through the legal side of your case. And an experienced therapist or counselor can help you to deal with the emotional pieces. In a similar way, financial professionals are available to assist you with the financial effects of divorce. Divorce doesn't have to mean financial devastation! Here are some tips to keep in mind as you work on the financial aspect of your divorce.

BE REALISTIC ABOUT INCOME AND EXPENSES. It is a rare couple who will not feel the financial effects of a divorce. In almost all cases, there is at least some sort of necessary lifestyle adjustment. It's the natural result of separating one household into two. And the days of depending on support payments to carry you through the rest of your life – especially if you are on the younger side – are all but gone.

If you divorce in California, your attorney will have you fill out a form known as an "Income and Expense Declaration." This form shows everything you earn and everything you spend. While you don't want to underestimate the dollar amount you will need to meet your living expenses post-divorce, you also don't want to be unreasonable. This form is also valuable to help you create a new budget as you move forward.

BE MINDFUL OF TAXES. The recent Tax Reform Act created some significant changes regarding spousal support payments. For couples whose divorce is finalized after January 1, 2019, spousal support payments will no longer be tax deductible for the payor nor included in the taxable income of the payee. While the short and long-term consequences of this provision have yet to be determined, it is highly likely the amount of spousal support payments will decrease.

Don't forget your filing status will also change after a divorce. You may file as "Married Filing Jointly" so long as you were still legally married as of December 31st of the year for which you are filing. It is important to keep your future filing status in mind while you are negotiating the terms of your divorce. If you have the ability to file as "Head of Household," you will see a greater tax benefit than simply filing as "Single."

DON'T FORGET INSURANCE. It is crucial that the spouse who receives support payments have a life insurance policy on the spouse who pays them. In addition, the payee spouse should be the owner of the policy, the beneficiary, and the one who pays the

premiums. Don't rely on your spouse's life insurance through his or her employment! In many cases, those policies will not provide enough coverage and you will never have 100% control over your name being taken off as the beneficiary.

If you've relied on your spouse for health insurance, make sure to account for increased costs once you are on your own in your new budget. It is also a good idea to at least investigate the possibility of buying long term care insurance. Women, especially, have a likelihood of needing care toward the end of our lives.

PROTECT YOUR RETIREMENT ASSETS. We often think of our retirement accounts as "yours" and "mine," especially since accounts such as IRAs and 401(k)s are held in an individual's name. However, retirement assets accrued during the marriage are considered community property. Without getting too complex, the general rule is that gains or returns on separate property investments are likely also community property. And these assets may be one of the largest of your marital estate.

All too often, one spouse will fight to keep the house and "make up the difference" by walking away from their interest in the retirement accounts. Unless you have a very large marital estate – or would be able to meet all of the expenses of the home without your former spouse's help – this is usually a bad idea and can have severe consequences on your financial future. Think carefully before you forgo retirement assets and utilize a financial planner to analyze the true cost of making such a decision.

While there is no "ideal divorce," your ideal goal should be to have your family law attorney, your CPA, and a financial advisor experienced with divorce cases work together to guide you through this time. Employing the right team of professionals can help to smooth out your transition period and prevent your divorce from being any more of a financial stress than it needs to be. **a**


