
#### Elizabeth Smart

Abductee to Activist and Advocate

ost of you will remember Elizabeth Smart, the 14-year-old girl abducted at knifepoint from her bedroom inside her family's Salt Lake City home in 2002. She was held captive for nine months while her desperate parents agonized trying to find their daughter. Miraculously, Elizabeth was found and rescued by police officers on a street in Sandy, Utah in March 2003. The trauma she suffered was beyond most people's comprehension. Since then, Elizabeth has turned her nightmare into society's gain by becoming one of the strongest advocates for children and missing persons. Her valuable work as a profoundly knowledgeable activist and advocate is an inspiring reversal of circumstances: the child victim has become a powerful champion for human rights, and the work she does is immeasurably important for society. The courageous Elizabeth Smart has triumphed since her ordeal.

In 2006, Smart spoke before the United States Congress to support sexual predator legislation and the AMBER Alert system. Soon after, she spoke at an event held following the signing of the Adam Walsh Act. Smart was one of five recovered young adults who contributed entries to the 2008 book You're Not Alone, which was published by the U.S. Department of Justice. In 2009, she spoke at the 2009 Women's Conference in California (hosted by Maria Shriver) on the topic of overcoming obstacles in life. In 2011, she founded the Elizabeth Smart Foundation, which aims to bring hope and end the victimization and exploitation of sexual assault through prevention, recovery, and advocacy. In 2011, ABC News announced that she would work as a commentator - focusing on missing persons.

Most recently, Elizabeth Smart helped Tanya Kach share her story on Lifetime TV, and her words on Instagram were powerful:



"Sharing stories is important because it helps us learn, grow compassion, and reexamine ourselves and how we pass judgement on those around us. Do we really know another person's circumstances well enough to say, "they should have done ..." or "I would never do ......"

Tanya's story is one of those stories that helps teach us about the vulnerability of children, grooming, the grit to survive, and the force of will it takes to reclaim one's life."





Championships in Budapest when he withdrew from the final of the 100 freestyle, despite having the second-best time in the semi-finals. Olympic swimming is an indescribably demanding sport. It requires a level of mental fortitude unlike any other sport. Three years ago, Dressel's swim times were faster than Michael Phelps. Week one of the Paris Olympics will test whether he is able to regain those lightning-quick times. Dressel emphasizes the monumental pressure of these Paris Games where your whole life's work gets tested in just two minutes, and you win or lose by one hundredth of a second.

This three-time Olympic champion admits that he's now the elder statesman of Team USA, and the world is rooting for a man who not only earned 7 Olympics gold medals but who also has an immeasurably valuable heart of gold.



the joy of competition, even in the face of adversity. Her positive mental outlook and a great support system provides the springboard to her success.

Katie has just released her book, *Just Add Water*, in which she shares what it takes to compete at an elite level.

The book charts Katie's life in swimming. It details her start in Bethesda, Maryland, where she played sharks and minnows and first discovered the joy of the pool; her early foray into the Olympics at the tender age of fifteen where, as the youngest member of the American team, she stunned everyone by winning her first gold medal.

We learn about Katie's time balancing competition and her education at Stanford University; how she developed a champion's mindset that has allowed her to persevere through so many meets, even under intense pressure; and how she has maintained her dominance in a sport where success depends on milliseconds.

You learn how every element of her life—from the support of her family to the tutelage of her coaches, from her childhood spent in summer league swimming to the bright lights of Olympic pools in London, Rio, Tokyo and Paris—set her up to become the champion she is.

In the end, Katie's story is about testing herself against the difficult, and seeing who she can become on the other side.

"Swimming hit me differently than other sports. It was love at first plunge. It provided resistance. That elemental shift from moving through air to moving through water was the heart of my relationship with the pool. Water made me feel weightless even as it forced me to pull more weight while I swam. In a pool, I was unencumbered and able to flip and turn and spin my body in every direction. When I wasn't in the pool. I yearned for the buoyancy. I craved the resistance. I wanted to test my limits in the water. So, I did, starting at age six, and never once stopping."

"I swam my first race on June 25, 2003. I was never some kind of prodigy who dove into the water and was able to zoom to the end. Something sparked as my eyes landed on the other swimmers cruising by. I always smile when I think about that first race. My observations as



an eager, exhausted six-year-old have become the template for my whole swimming journey. *Great. Hard. Just trying to finish.*"

"In the twenty years since that day, swimming has not ceased being hard. Uniquely so. It tests my body and my psyche equally. It challenges me like a marathon - with the added burden of the force of water reminding me with every stroke what I'm up against. The hard is kind of what makes swimming great. Giving your best effort has been baked into my DNA for generations. Trying hard is the whole point. I didn't grasp the significance of this when I was a kid. But some part of my brain or my body understood that happiness would result from being in a space where the mind can run quiet, and the body can try hard. Swimming is an unusual career in that it comes down to the will of the swimmer. I am the only one who has been in the pool with every stroke of the way."

"I've heard a lot of my swimming peers say that when they were young, they always knew they wanted to go to the Games, but that wasn't my experience. Back then I looked at the



Olympics and thought you had to be a superhero to reach that level. They seemed to be so fast, so focused, so otherworldly. Yet here I am, entering my fourth Olympics in Paris."

"For as long as I've been swimming, I've had people asking how I got where I am. They speculate about my physiology, analyze the geometry of my body, comb through my training. For a lot of people in the sporting community, I am a code that, if cracked, will enable them to replicate my results. In this book, I lay out all the ingredients of my swimming life."

After reading Katie's book, I found these words from her particularly powerful:

"Swimming has rendered me into someone I wouldn't be otherwise. Long after another swimmer breaks my records, I'll still have the benefit of being raised in and by the pool. I hope my tenacity outlasts any blip of athletic fame. That would be the gift of a lifetime."



#### Don't Overlook The Beet

By Model Gardener Kelly Emberg



ou can grow anything you dream of in a Southern California vegetable garden, no matter what the month is. Some veggies you can actually grow year round, like the lovely, the colorful, and sometimes overlooked beet! This versatile root veggie is packed with nutrition and flavor. Eat them raw, cooked, pickled or roasted. Puree them, juice them, heck, use the juice to paint a watercolor masterpiece! It's not just about the roots, though. Beet tops can be used as a substitute for spinach or Swiss chard - sauteed, steamed, or added to soups and stews. There is almost nothing this veggie can't do. And the best part is, they are easy to grow!

#### **GROWING BEETS FROM SEED**

Beets enjoy warm days and cool nights so August & September is a perfect month to start sowing your beetroot seeds which should germinate in about five days. If you want to speed up the process, soak the seeds for an hour or overnight in warm water. Beet seeds are rather large, and are multigerms. Each one is a cluster that contains between two and five seeds. Once they grow you will have to thin them out. Amend your soil prior to planting time with compost. Sow a half-inch deep and 1 to 2 inches apart. Beets can be planted fairly densely, but if you overcrowd them, they won't grow to their full potential. Once they germinate and grow to 3 or 4 inches tall, thin the seedlings to one plant every 3 to 4 inches. Select the sturdiest in the seed clump and snip

the others with scissors. Enjoy the thinned plants as a garnish or in a baby green salad, delicious!

#### WATERING BEETS

Beets like moist but not soaked soil. Beets' taproots grow high, sticking well out of the ground, so water gently to avoid washing the soil away. Test to see if you need to water by pushing your finger straight down into the soil all the way and if it comes out clean, it's time to water.

#### **FERTILIZING BEETS**

If you planted beets in soil that is rich in organic matter and well amended with compost, your beets are off to a great start. When they reach two inches tall: Start fertilizing every three weeks, using a small

pinch per plant. Place the organic fertilizer an inch away from the plant, but make sure it doesn't touch it, as this could burn it.

#### **HARVESTIING BEETS**

If the beet greens are large and lush, your beet roots are likely filling out nicely; once the greens are starting to wilt, your beets may be past their prime and they should be dug up right away. Check if they are ready by pushing away the soil around the base of your beet greens and expose the top 1/3 of the beet root. If they are the size of a golf ball or larger, they should be ready to harvest. If not, cover them back up with a bit of soil and they should be ready in a week or two.

#### When you are ready to harvest:

- Water the garden well the day before.
- Loosen the soil around the roots with a trowel or garden fork, being careful not to damage the roots.
- Grab the beet plant at the base of its greens and gently pull upwards to lift the beet from the soil. If the soil is hard, you can try placing your trowel under a beet root and levering it up while pulling on the beet greens.

Harvest beets at different stages of their growth. For baby beets, harvest when they are the size of a golf ball, their skin is still so soft that it won't need peeling. Fully matured beets are harvested when they're the size of a tennis ball. Their tougher skin makes them ideal for winter storage.

Enjoy the beet greens while its root is maturing. Snip off a few leaves from each plant once they get 2 to 3 inches tall, always leaving some leaves attached to your beet roots.

Beets don't need to be harvested right away and can remain fresh in your garden for up to four months. If beets are left to grow for too long, they can become fibrous and tough.

#### ALL TOP AND NO BOTTOM

Beet plants will grow leaves instead of roots if overfertilization. Using high nitrogen fertilizers on root crops can encourage plants to use all of their energy on leaf development and roots may become stunted. Beet plants may also produce small roots if the soil is compacted or nutrient deficient or if beets are planted too closely together.

#### SOME OF MY FAVORITE BEET VARIETIES

#### Avalanche

An open-pollinated white cultivar with a sweet, mild flavor. The creamy-white roots have all the sweetness of a red beet with no hint of bitterness. Mild in flavor with a crunchy texture. Great for slicing raw in salads. Delicious roasted or added to soups and stews. Round roots are best harvested when they are two to three inches in diameter, after about 50 days. The light green tops can be enjoyed sauteed.

#### **Bull's Blood**

This heirloom has deep purple leaves and

can be harvested as microgreens to add color to salads, or sauteed like Swiss chard. Roots are deep red, with a sweet, slightly earthy flavor and no hint of bitterness – especially when harvested young. Roots mature in 55 days and tops can be harvested after just 30 days.

#### Chioggia

Also known as 'Candy stripe,' this is an eye-catching heirloom named after a small fishing town near Venice, Italy. When you slice this beet open you will find concentric rings of pink and white. The delicate, sweet flavor and unusual pattern adds a pop of color to salads. Once cooked, the rings fade.

#### **Golden Detroit**

Sweet and mild, heirloom cultivar 'Golden Detroit' produces one to three-inch oval shaped orange-yellow roots. Delicious both raw and cooked. Light green tops with pale stems have no hint of bitterness and are an ideal addition to summer salads. Roots mature after 55 days. Harvest leaves after 40-45 days.

**Beet Greens** 

#### **Ruby Queen**

She grows happily in poor soil, and her perfectly round, two to three-inch deep-red roots are especially suitable for canning, with a sweet, mild flavor and toothsome texture. Her short tops grow to just 10 to 12

inches tall, and roots can be harvested after just 55 days.

#### **HEALTH BENEFITS OF BEETS**

The first benefit to growing beets is they can detoxify your blood and liver. Packed with nutrition, beets have antioxidants that fight cell damage and inflammation, potentially offering protection against cancer and heart disease. Health benefits of beets include more stamina during exercise, heart disease and stroke prevention, and lower blood pressure.

#### WATERCOLOR RECIPE

- 1. Cut the beets into cubes.
- 2. Add to a saucepan. Use just enough water to cover the beets and simmer on low for about 30 minutes.
- 3. Strain the beets or remove them from the pot using a colander or slotted spoon. Set aside the liquid to cool.
- 4. Add a splash of white vinegar. Your red paint is ready!

The overlooked, easy to grow, beetroot should not be left unnoticed any longer! In fact, it should never be forgotten again. There is so much this nutritious, versatile, delicious root veggie will gift you. Grow, harvest, eat and store them all year long. You would be crazy not to add them to your garden this fall season.



# BROCKE SHIELDS The Soul Inside Pretty Baby

Brooke Shields was world famous before she blew out her first birthday candle. At just 11 months old, her face was ubiquitously recognizable across the globe. By age 12, she was the lead actress in 'Pretty Baby' (1978), a film set in 1917 New Orleans wherein photographer, Ernest J. Bellocq, marries 12-year-old Violet (Brooke).

By the time Brooke crossed the threshold from childhood into adolescence, she was one of the ten most famous people on this planet with a staggering amount of camera voltage following her every move. Yet, despite being perpetually photographed, filmed and recorded, she maintained a colossal amount of dignity and poise in the face of unrelenting intrusiveness.

At just 14 years old, Brooke Shields became the youngest cover model on Vogue magazine. That same year, designer Calvin Klein capitalized on Brooke's beauty and fame in his denim jeans commercials. He subsequently received one of the first major backlashes to the blatant sexualization of a teenage girl. The irony is that despite Brooke's suggestive tagline, 'You want to know what comes between me and my Calvin's?' she was one of the most chaste teenagers in the USA – becoming America's virgin symbol for abstinence, and Nancy Reagan's favorite young celebrity for a drug-free USA.

hen interviewers cornered Brooke, she stood her ground with a calm resolve seldom ever encountered in someone so young. She refused to be steam-rolled, and politely suggested that it was time to move on to another question. She learned in her teenage years that when the captains of industries turned her into a commodity, they took away her voice, and she yearned to resurrect the voice that kept her rational faculties intact.

Despite Brooke's box office successes in movies like 'Pretty Baby', 'Blue Lagoon' and 'Endless Love', it took the comedic route for her to naturally find her niche in a comfort zone wherein she beamed. With her self-deprecating humor fully charged, she went about downplaying her beauty in her 1997 hit comedy show, 'Suddenly Susan', for which she received a People's Choice Award. She hammed up her railway-track braces as badges of honor, tripped over her own feet, and had a blast being regular, struggling Susan.

None of this is surprising when one hears Brooke's closest childhood friends describe her as always laughing, and a bright, outward-looking child who was completely unaffected and disconnected from the camera. Brooke describes 'Suddenly Susan' as one of the happiest times in her professional life.

In this timely cover story, we are celebrating the recent Netflix May 2024 release of 'Mother of the Bride' in which Brooke sparkles as Lana, the mother of Emma (the bride). If you are looking for a wonderfully positive summer family movie shot in beautiful Phuket, Thailand, this is it, with Brooke in her element as mama Lana who is starting her own new, fulfilling chapter in life. I ask her about the whole 'Mother of the Bride' filming experience.

"We had the most delightful time all being together," she says. "It was like going to summer camp, if you are one of those who likes summer camp, and it was wonderful to be in Phuket for over three months with terrific actors and comedians. We were all together in this beautiful environment wherein we spent all our free time together. Typically, on a movie location, everybody tends to go their separate ways at the end of the day's shooting, but we stayed together with such a special camaraderie – much like if you were on tour with a theater production. We bonded with activities like pickleball, and it was all so unique and fun."

For Brooke, particularly important in 'Mother of the Bride' is the uplifting message about a middle-aged wom-

an's right to new-found love, and she explains:

"From the perspective of the story line of the movie, it is about a woman in my age bracket who gets this second chance in life to find her own happiness. I was so happy that we could have a story line about that opportunity of having people vying for a mature woman because of her value. It mirrored what life looks like. I think in previous generations, society told us that attractiveness had an expiration date. We were programmed to believe that women of a certain age couldn't be sexy. They'd done their duty by bearing children and raising them properly, and their mission in life was accomplished. This movie negates that outdated concept."

Brooke's humor is immediately prevalent as she quips with an amusing inflection in her voice,

"Granted, not everyone looks like Benjamin Bratt!" (Benjamin is her love interest in the movie.)

"This idea that your daughter is starting a beautiful new chapter in her life by getting married, and that the mother of the bride gets to open her own happy chapter is wonderful. I was so honored to be a part of that positivity."

In Brooke's extensive career, she has more than proved her acting worth on Broadway in 'Wonderful Town', 'Chicago', 'Cabaret' and 'Grease', and her comedic chops in NBC's television series 'Suddenly Susan' and 'Lipstick Jungle'.

Strongly evident is the central role of humor in Brooke's under-the-microscope life, and she endorses that emphatically.

"Humor is like oxygen," she says passionately. "I have such an attachment to comedy because of how it allows all the dramatic moments to really resonate. If you have that lightness, it juxtaposes the really serious moments. If you think about it, even within the scope of tragedy, there are some truly funny moments. In a movie like 'Mother of the Bride' – humor is central to the movie's value."

I ask Brooke if humor abounded at home when she was a child.

Somewhere in that little person was a mind that was able to dissect information and not let it destroy her. I seemed to be able to navigate those perfect storms







"Oh, yes! I grew up with a great deal of humor. Both my mother and my father were very funny in very different ways, so my whole childhood, and the places wherein I found solace, centered around laughing."

It goes much deeper, given the complexity of her life and she explains.

"Comedy became my comforter – even in the lowest moments or the most uncomfortable situations. Humor is about finding levity in the darkest times. It's not about making a joke at someone's expense or about making fun at something that's genuinely serious. Rather, it's about humor giving us breathing space so that we can better face the heavy situation. I find it truly liberating and a healthy escape from taking oneself so seriously. Humor gives people permission to let it all out. It's a great de-stressing mechanism."

Given the pressures that Brooke faced as a child, as a teenager, and during her early adult life which included a high-profile marriage to tennis legend, Andre Agassi, she comments in her 2023 documentary entitled 'Pretty Baby' (Hulu) that she became an expert at compartmentalization from a young age.

I wonder if Brooke still views compartmentalizing as a useful coping skill in life, and she responds thoughtfully.

"I think that if we learn to tap into compartmentalizing strategically and knowledgably, and not use it to escape reality, it can really work for you. If one uses compartmentalization for avoidance purposes, then it starts to become dangerous."

Brooke and husband Chris Henchy have two daughters, Rowan and Grier, who are now 21 and 18 years old. We share an in-depth chat on parenting in the 2020s, which seems appropriate given Brooke's latest movie, and the fact that she always wanted to be a mom. The era in which she grew up is vastly different from today, and her parenting style is much different from her mother Terry, who was her steely career 'momanger'. I ask Brooke if she feels that young people are being raised in a much healthier environment today.

"Yes and no," she answers carefully. "On the one hand, every young person now is emboldened to hold very strong opinions, and they are also told that they deserve the world. It's a good thing to have opinions and to utilize that freedom of expression but there is a flip side, and it plays out in social media. The issue I have with social media is that it is often a distortion of the truth. It's a carefully crafted piece of fiction that is put out there, and the audience doesn't know

that it's a distortion on reality."

"From the perspective of my children," she continues, "they've grown up being seen and heard whereas my generation - definitely - were seen and NOT heard. My situation was slightly different because my mom and I talked about a lot of things together, but I also remember having this fear of not wanting to disappoint my mother. I've learned from that and have worked really hard at making sure that my daughters don't feel that fear. They are not afraid to voice their opinions, and I encourage them to speak their minds - whether that's hard for me to hear or not. The point is that it has nothing to do with me. It has everything to do with them and their level of comfort in being forthright."

We discuss the pros and cons of the confidence-boosting techniques that parents and teachers employ with Gen Z's. Brooke's response is reliably rational.

"I'm not a proponent of every child getting a gold medal, because that doesn't teach our kids about reality. But I do believe we are on the right track when it comes to giving our children the platform to express all their opinions. I never did that with my mother because it was taboo back then, and that's not something I want in our family. It's not healthy."

"I'd say my concern about raising children in the 2020s," she continues, "is that they have been given so many tools and choices, and not all of them are healthy. As parents, we'll have to do a serious recalibration – particularly when pendulums have swung too far in a particular direction. I'm hoping that some moderation will happen and that we can swing back to a more moderate median on some key issues."

Brooke is one of the few mega famous people whose lifelong reputation is one of respect. She's been a decades-long symbol of the responsible woman who's conducted herself with dignity and integrity. Her academic grades earned her a coveted spot at Princeton University. Her maturity level as a child star far surpassed her chronological years, and I wonder if she was aware of it at the time.

"When I watched the final product of my 2023 documentary, 'Pretty Baby', she remembers, "I admit to giving myself more credit than I ever would have done in previous years. When I look back at all the interviews of me as a child, I am struck by the poise with which I conducted myself. I'm proud of the fact that even when I was eleven years old, I was able to push back at an interviewer and stand my ground by saying, 'I think I have already answered that question and it seems that you don't want my answer. Maybe we should go on to a different question."

Brooke goes on to say:

"Somewhere in that little person was a mind that was able to dissect information and not let it destroy her. I seemed to be able to navigate those perfect storms. I must give both my parents a lot of credit. Each of their lives was very different and they exposed me to very different situations. Each had a pro and a con. My mom had a great sense of humor, and she kept me away from Hollywood. My dad was very firm about conveying to me that we were not to acknowledge my fame or being an actress. I guess it was classic compartmentalization. I was told that all of that was never my real life. That turned out to be healthy because when it got taken away from me at various phases of my life, it wasn't a calamity. My education was the priority, and I was able to transition over to Princeton University without missing a beat. That was something sacred to me. I knew that nobody could take my education away from me. I was shown these alternative paths and so Hollywood never had an opportunity to consume my whole identity. I could never be branded as that star child that never got an education. Despite the implicit message I received from Hollywood of 'you have left us to go and get an education,' I knew that it was vital for me. Hollywood wanted to own me and never have me question them. I chose to do what I knew was important for me and I wasn't going to be Svengali-ed by them."

We discuss the all-important topic of finding one's identity. Brooke has determinedly come into her own – truly solidifying her very strong identity.

"I think that sense of ownership is real now," she explains, "because when I was a young woman, I had to behave and react to particular situations. I was never the initiator. I was never allowed the luxury of thinking, 'is this what I want?' Add to that the fact that I had a mother that I looked up to. She made all the decisions for me. I was often voiceless."

"I think the closest I ever came to a real identity in Holly-wood was in comedy. In 'Suddenly Susan' and in 'Lipstick', I owned what was funny, and nobody could argue that with me. Those were my choices, whether you found them funny or not. I gained so much confidence in my comedy and in having opinions. If you look at other life choices, you get married and you have children. Then you are defined as

'just a mom'. It takes a long time to separate yourself from all those relationships that have preceded you. I'm at a stage now where my children are off to college, and I have the freedom to indulge in getting to know myself. I've always had a sense of who I am, but it's never felt like the freedom that it now is. There's been a shift. I'm more selfish in a healthy way. I have more joy. I don't take everything so seriously and I realize that most things don't signal the end of the world. The things that I used to ascribe so much weight to – I have a more realistic perspective on. I'm way past the devastating reactionary phase of my younger days."

The Mother's Act of 2007 was passed by Congress. It came about after Brooke went public about the postpartum depression that she suffered after the birth of her first daughter, Rowan. She even wrote a book about it entitled, 'Down Came the Rain'. She was instrumental in bringing to light a clinical condition filled with hidden shame that millions of women suffered worldwide. Until Brooke spoke up about the paralyzing condition, little was understood about it, and ignorance abounded. The significance of her proactive steps made history. She de-mystified postpartum and gave mothers permission to seek help. Looking back, she is proud of how she took her own devastating experience out of the darkness and helped others to find the light.

"When I went public about my own experience," she explains, "the reaction I received confirmed to me how necessary it was to understand postpartum depression. I do recognize that my going public about it was a catalyst and a conduit to gaining better insight and doing something constructive with that insight."


Brooke is quick to bring humor into the discussion by comedically knocking herself off the credit platform with the reminder that she didn't provide the scientific breakthrough.

"I will never say that I single-handedly moved the mountain because I didn't. What I am proud about is that I had the courage to tell my story. I was able to supersede the debilitating concept of fear, shame and embarrassment about my own condition. By doing that, it opened up the dialogue so that other people could tell their stories. I always hesitate to take credit for anything. Many professionals had been

I was able to transition over to Princeton University without missing a beat. That was something sacred to me. I knew that nobody could take my education away from me. Despite the implicit message I received from Hollywood of 'you have left us to go and get an education,' I wasn't going to be Svengali-ed by them

doing extensive research on the topic, and they had shared their knowledge, but they didn't get the attention they should have gotten. What I did was use my public figure platform to open up the conversation."

Brooke's younger daughter, Grier, recently made the decision to pursue a modeling career, and I ask Brooke how she felt about her child going in a direction that she knows is complex.

"The hardest thing is not making your children's decisions about you," she says. "It's about them. I was a young female in an industry where I was objectified, and so I've had substantial experience on the pros and the cons. What I do know is that I have no desire to be my daughter's manager like my mother was for me. I was clear about not giving up my life like my mom did to provide me with the protection she determined I needed. Here's what I also realized, and this is important: I don't know the modeling industry. I never considered myself a professional model. Yeah, I did Calvin Klein campaigns as a teenager, but I never walked in fashion shows. I don't know the ins and the outs of the industry. I have great respect for the super models of our era, but I wasn't a part of that world. What I've done for Grier is get her an agent – so that they can protect her."

"I also realize as a parent that you cannot protect your children from everything, and that life is about going through the pain. Getting hurt is part of life. You spend the first 20 years of your children's lives trying to keep them out of harm's way. After that, if they fall down and skin their knees, hopefully they'll learn a valuable lesson. When my girls were little kids, I never dramatized their falls. If they tripped on something, I reacted positively by saying, 'that was a smart fall. Let's get up.' That way you keep their fear at bay, and they learn to pick themselves up without a fuss being made. Fast forward to my daughter and modeling, I try to be sensible. She's still going to college. That's four years, and she has summers and plenty of time to figure out what works for her."

We touch on the interesting topic of 'nepo' babies. It's a term derived from 'nepotistic' and refers to children with famous parents who pull strings to open doors for them.

"People are quick to say, 'oh, so-in-so got the job because of who her mom is, or, he got chosen because he's a famous director's son'. I say, name one lawyer or doctor who didn't encourage their kid by making one phone call for them. As a parent, that's what you do for your kid. You help them when you can. However, if your kid doesn't have any talent, he's never going to make it. One of my daughters has worked at 'Good Morning America' for the last three years. She's a communication major and even if I put a call in to someone to open a door, I make it clear to her that the rest is up to her. She has to prove her worth by working harder than everyone else. It means going to work earlier and going above and beyond."

"I'm extremely excited about it," she says enthusiastically. "It's my first experience being a Founder and CEO. It all germinated during Covid as an online experience where I was a community advocate for women over 40."

"My favorite food dish is total comfort food. If I'm going to indulge, it's going to be really, really delicious spaghetti with a flavorful basil sauce."

Her family's favorite relaxation past-time?

"Laughing together," she says unhesitatingly. "It's even more special when that laughter is accompanied by traveling together. My dream is to explore more countries with my family."

It seems appropriate, given Brooke's extensive life experience, to ask her what the secret is to finding contentment and peace. Her answer is filled with unwavering certainty:

"Stopping myself every time I take myself out of the place I'm in right now! It's about not looking back or looking too far forward and worrying about the future – to the point where your head starts to spin. I'm learning to stop that and come back to the center. I consciously take a deep breath and imbibe all the blessings I have NOW – not the things that I don't have or the things I could lose."

So, you see why, when the quiet luxury trend emerged on the international fashion scene, I was excited. like I belonged there - a fashionista hasbeen, frayed around the edges and effectively invisible. I didn't want to fight for visibility either, with pitiful weapons beneath my dignity. 


# Market Performance During An Election Year

he four-year United States presidential election cycle is a theory that stock markets are weakest in the year following the election of a new U.S. president. It suggests that the presidential election has a predictable impact on America's economic policies and market sentiment irrespective of the specific policies of the President. It goes on to suggest the levels of stocks for each of the four-years of the presidential term as part of an stock market cycles. [1][2]

#### ANNUAL CHANGE IN NON-FARM PAYROLL




The four-year U.S. presidential cycle is attributed to politics and its impact on America's economic policies. Either or both of these factors could be the cause for the stock market's sta-

tistically improved performance during most of the third and fourth years of a president's four-year term.<sup>[3]</sup> The month-end seasonality cycle is attributed to the automatic purchases associated with retirement accounts. The secular stock market cycles that last about 30 years move in lockstep with corresponding secular economic, social, and political cycles in the US.<sup>[4]</sup>

#### ANNUAL CHANGE IN UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

Stock market returns are also higher under Democratic presidents. [5] CNN reported in September 2020 that: "Since 1945, the S&P 500 has averaged an annual gain of 11.2% during years when Democrats controlled the White House, according to CFRA Research. That's well ahead




of the 6.9% average gain under Republicans." [6] Analysis conducted by S&P Capital IQ in 2016 found similar results since 1901. [7] Blinder and Watson estimated that the S&P 500 returned

8.4% annually on average under Democrats, versus 2.7% under Republicans, a difference of 5.7% percentage points. This computation used

the average value in last year of the president's term, minus the average value in last year of previous term.<sup>[8]</sup>

#### JOB CREATION AND RECESSIONS



The Washington Post cited a study by CFRA Research that the stock market (as measured by the S&P 500) averaged the following annual rates of return, under

different control scenarios, from 1945 to September 2020:[9]

- 1. Democratic president with split Congress: 13.6%
- 2. Democratic president with Republican Congress: 13.0%
- 3. Republican president with Republican Congress: 12.9%
- 4. Democratic president with Democratic Congress: 9.8%
- 5. Republican president with split Congress: 5.8%
- 6. Republican president with Democratic Congress: 4.9%

CNN reported in October 2020 that 10 of the last 11 recessions started under Republican presidents, and that "Every Republican president since Benjamin Harrison, who served from 1889 to 1893, had a recession start in their first term in office." [10] NBER reports the start date of recessions; the following list includes the president in office at that time and their party: [11] Blinder and Watson estimated that the economy was in recession for 49 quarters from 1949-2013; 8 of these quarters were under Democrats, with 41 under Republicans. [12] The 2020 recession brings that to 50 quarters total in recession, 42 under Republicans (84%) and 8 under Democrats (16%). [13]






